Activity: Clock Strikes One

Children count the “bongs” as the clock strikes and choose the correct hour to place the mouse on.

The Quiet Mouse

Once there lived a quiet mouse (*show thumb*)

In a quiet little house. (*hide thumb in fist*)

When all was quiet as can be, (*put finger to lips*)

OUT POPPED HE! (*pop thumb up*)

Way Up in a House

Way up in the house (*form a roof with hands*)

Creeps the mama mouse (*crawl right hand on top of left forearm*)

While down in the nest (*form cup shape with right hand under left arm*)

The little mice rest (*mime sleeping*)

Shhh! They're sleeping. (*stage whisper shhh- Yell 'they're sleeping'*)

With a whisker on the left (*use right index finger to make left whisker*)

And a whisker on the right (*use left index finger to make right whisker*)

The little mice sleep all through the night (*mime sleeping*)

Shhh! They're sleeping

The bright sun comes up (*arms form circle and raise over head*)

The dew goes away (*pass hands in front of you*)

“Good morning” the little mice say. (*yell 'good morning'*)

The clock song

Now it's one o'clock, one o'clock, one o'clock,

Now it's one o'clock, and what do we do at one o'clock?

Have a nap.

Now it's two o'clock, two o'clock, two o'clock,

Now it's two o'clock, and what do we do at two o'clock?

Wake up!

Three o'clock –go out and play

Four o'clock-visit the neighbor

Five o'clock- have supper

Six o'clock-have a bath, etc.

Tick Tock

Tick tock, tick tock,

I'm a little cuckoo clock.

Tick tock, tick tock

Now I'm striking one o'clock.

(*Swing child from side to side and then life up on 1 o'clock – child says "cuckoo."*)

Clocks

Big clocks make a sound like t-i-c-k, t-o-c-k, t-i-c-k, t-o-c-k. (*Rest elbows on hips; extend forearms and index fingers up and move arms sideways slowly and rhythmically.*)

Small clocks make a sound like tick, tock, tick, tock.

(*move arms faster*)

And the very tiny clocks make a sound like tick, tock, tick, tock,

(*move very fast*)
